

## THE LIGHT – JESUS & HIS WORD

Older and Newer Testament verses about the Light, our Lord Jesus Christ.

GENESIS 1:3-4: “And God said, ‘Let there be LIGHT; and there was LIGHT. And God saw the LIGHT, that it was good: and God divided the LIGHT from darkness.’ (Jesus, the LIGHT, the Creator of it.)

JOB 24:13: “They (evil men) are of those that rebel against the LIGHT (God’s Word); they know not the ways thereof, nor abide in the paths thereof.”

PSALM 27:1: “The Lord is my LIGHT and my salvation; whom shall I fear? The Lord is the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid.”

PSALM 36:9: “For with Thee (God) is the fountain of life: in Thy LIGHT we shall see LIGHT.”

PSALM 43:3: “O send out Thy LIGHT and Thy truth: let them lead me; let them bring me unto Thy holy hill, and to Thy tabernacles.”

PSALM 97:11: “LIGHT is sown for the righteous, and gladness for the upright in heart.”

PSALM 119:105: “Thy Word is a LAMP unto my feet, and a LIGHT unto my path.”

PSALM 119:130: “The entrance of Thy Words giveth LIGHT; it giveth understanding to the simple.”

PSALM 104:1-2: “Bless the Lord, O my soul. O Lord my God, Thou art very great; Thou art clothed with honor and majesty. Who coverest Thyself with LIGHT as with a garment; Who stretches out the heavens like a curtain.”

ISAIAH 2:5: “O house of Jacob, come ye, and let us walk in the LIGHT of the Lord.”

ISAIAH 9:2: “The people that walked in darkness have seen a great LIGHT (Jesus); they that dwell in the land of the shadow of death, upon them hath the LIGHT (Jesus) shined.”

ISAIAH 42:6-7: “I the Lord have called thee in righteousness, and will hold thine hand, and will keep thee, and give thee for a covenant of the people, for a LIGHT of the Gentiles; to open the blind eyes, to bring out the prisoners from the prison, and them that sit in darkness out of the prison house.”

ISAIAH 49:6: “And He (God) said, It is a light thing that thou shouldest be My Servant (Christ the Messiah) to raise up the tribes of Jacob, and to restore the preserved of Israel: I will also give Thee for a LIGHT to the Gentiles, that Thou mayest be My salvation to the end of the earth.”

ISAIAH 60:1-2: “Arise, shine; for Thy LIGHT (Jesus) is come, and the glory of the Lord is risen upon thee. For, behold, the darkness shall cover the earth, and gross darkness the people: but the Lord shall arise upon thee, and His glory shall be seen upon thee.”

ISAIAH 60:19-20: “The sun shall be no more thy light by day; neither for brightness shall the moon give light unto thee: but the Lord shall be unto thee (in Israel’s future) an everlasting LIGHT, and thy God thy glory. The sun shall no more go down; neither shall the moon withdraw itself; for the Lord shall be thine everlasting LIGHT, and the days of thy mourning shall be ended.”

MATTHEW 4:16: “The people which sat in darkness saw great LIGHT; and to them which sat in the region and shadow of death LIGHT is sprung up.”

MATTHEW 17:2: “And (Jesus) was transfigured before them: and His face did shine as the sun, and His raiment was white as the LIGHT.”

LUKE 2:30-32: “For mine (Simeon) eyes have seen Thy salvation, which Thou hast prepared before the face of the people; a LIGHT to lighten the Gentiles, and the glory of Thy people Israel.”

JOHN 1:4-5, 7-9: “In Him (the Word, God the Son) was life; and the life was the LIGHT of men. And the LIGHT shineth in darkness; and the darkness comprehended (or apprehended) it not... The same (John the Baptist) came for a witness, to bear witness of the LIGHT, that all men through Him might believe... He (John) was not that LIGHT, but was sent to bear witness of that LIGHT. That was the true LIGHT, which LIGHTETH every man that cometh into the world.”

JOHN 3: 19-21: “And this is the condemnation, that LIGHT is come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than LIGHT, because their deeds were evil. For everyone that doeth evil hateth the LIGHT, neither cometh to the LIGHT, lest his deeds should be reproved. But he that doeth truth cometh to the LIGHT, that his deeds may be made manifest, that they are wrought in God.”

JOHN 8:12: “Then spake Jesus again unto them, saying, I am the LIGHT of the world: he that followeth Me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the LIGHT of life.”

JOHN 9:5: “As long as I am in the world, I am the LIGHT of the world.”

JOHN 12:35-36, 46: “Then Jesus said unto them, Yet a little while is the LIGHT with you. Walk while you have the LIGHT, lest darkness come upon you: for he that walketh in darkness knows not where he goes. While you have LIGHT, believe in the LIGHT, that you may be the children of LIGHT... I am come a LIGHT unto the world, that whosoever believeth on Me should not abide in darkness.”

ACTS 13:47: “For so hath the Lord commanded us, saying, I have set Thee to be a LIGHT of the Gentiles, that thou should be for salvation unto the ends of the earth.”

ACTS 22:6-11: “And it came to pass, that, as I (Paul) made my journey, and was come nigh unto Damascus about noon, suddenly there shone from heaven a great LIGHT (Jesus) round about me. And I fell unto the ground, and heard a voice saying unto me, Saul, Saul, why do you persecute Me? And I answered, Who art Thou, Lord? And He said unto me, I am Jesus of Nazareth, Whom thou persecutest. And they that were with me saw indeed the LIGHT, and were afraid; but they heard not the voice of Him that spoke to me. And I said, what shall I do, Lord? And the Lord said unto me, Arise, and go into Damascus; and there it shall be told thee of all things which are appointed for thee to do. And when I could not see for the glory of that LIGHT, being led by the hand of them that were with me, I came to Damascus.”

ACTS 26:13: “At midday, O king (Agrippa), I (Paul) saw in the way a LIGHT from heaven, above the brightness of the sun (Jesus) shining round about me and them which journeyed with me.”

ROMANS 13:12: “The night is far spent, the day is at hand: let us therefore cast off the works of darkness, and let us put on the armor of LIGHT.”

I CORINTHIANS 4:5: “Therefore judge nothing before the time, until the Lord come, Who both will bring to LIGHT the hidden things of darkness, and will make manifest (clear, plain) the counsels of the hearts: and then shall every man have praise of God.”

II CORINTHIANS 4:6: “For God, Who commanded the LIGHT to shine out of darkness, hath shined in our hearts, to give the LIGHT of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.”

EPHESIANS 5:8: “For you were sometimes darkness, but now are you LIGHT in the Lord: walk as children of LIGHT.”

COLOSSIANS 1:12: “Giving thanks unto the Father, Who has made us fit to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in LIGHT.”

I THESSALONIANS 5:5: “You are the children of LIGHT, and the children of the day: we are not of the night, nor of darkness.”

I TIMOTHY 6:16: “Who (King of kings and Lord of lords) only has immortality dwelling in the LIGHT which no man can approach unto; Whom no man has seen, nor can see: to Whom be honor and power everlasting. Amen.”

II TIMOTHY 1:10: “But is now made manifest (God’s purpose and grace for believers) by the appearing of our Savior Jesus Christ, Who has abolished death, and has brought life and immortality to LIGHT through the gospel.”

I PETER 2:9: “But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a peculiar (special possession) people; that you should show forth the praises of Him Who has called you out of darkness into His marvelous LIGHT.”

II PETER 1:19: “We have also a more sure word of prophecy; whereunto you do well that you take heed, as unto a LIGHT that shines in a dark place, until the day dawn, and the day star arise in your hearts.”

I JOHN 1:5-7: “This then is the message which we have heard of Him, and declare unto you, that God is LIGHT, and in Him is no darkness at all. If we say that we have fellowship with Him, and walk in darkness, we lie, and do not the truth; but if we walk in the LIGHT as He is in the LIGHT, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin.”

I JOHN 2:9-10: “He that says he is in the LIGHT and hates His brother, is in darkness, even until now. He that loves his brother abides in the LIGHT, and there is none occasion of stumbling in him.”

REVELATION 21:23-24: “And the city (New Jerusalem) had no need of the sun, neither of the moon, to shine in it: for the glory of God did LIGHTEN it, and the Lamb is the LIGHT thereof. And the nations of them which are saved shall walk in the LIGHT of it: and the kings of the earth do bring their glory and honor into it.”

REVELATION 22:5: “And there shall be no night there; and they need no candle, neither light of the sun; for the Lord God gives them LIGHT: and they shall reign forever and ever.”
